

When developing countries negotiate debt relief from their Paris Club creditors, including under the HIPC initiative, they are also required to seek comparable terms from their non-Paris Club bilateral creditors. However these negotiations are on a creditor-by-creditor basis and so information on the relief or restructuring terms is not so readily available.
